Esteemed Group of Featured Sommeliers to Showcase Their Talents with Some of the World's Most Extraordinary Wines at 2025 Naples Winter Wine Festival

NAPLES, FL (September 17, 2024) - The Naples Winter Wine Festival (NWWF) has unveiled its lineup of Featured Sommeliers headlining the 25th annual NWWF on January 24-26, 2025 at The Ritz-Carlton Naples, Tiburón. With three days of Festival activities, the NWWF will once again feature the world's top wines, exquisite cuisine and amazing auction lots benefitting local children.
